INSTRUCTIONS.

To Deflate Tyre to Desired Pressure

Before use, check & ensure there is no sand, mud, debris in valve stem or deflator.

- Loosen the locking nut & turn adjusting screw so that pressure indicator is set at desired pressure. (Fig. 1)
- Fig. 1

- 2. Lock adjusting screw using locking nut
- 3. Screw deflator body clockwise until firm onto valve stem. (Fig. 2)
- 4. Pull plunger up to start releasing air from deflator. (Fig. 3)



- 5. A faint popping noise can be heard when desired pressure is reached & deflation has stopped
- 6. Screw deflator anti clockwise to remove from valve stem
- 7. Place deflator in storage case



WARNING.

- Driving with reduced tyre pressures will affect vehicles handling performance
- Re-inflate tyre to vehicle manufacturers recommended tyre pressures before driving on sealed roads
